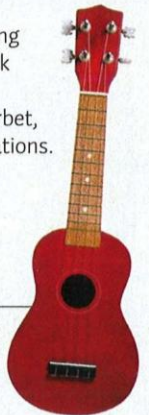
Mission Community Market

Expect to find hipster marmalade entrepreneurs alongside pupusa stands where tortillas are handmade right on site.



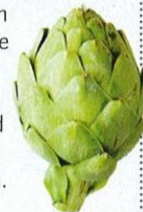
Impromptu break-dancing contests, folk bands like Orange Sherbet, and craft stations.



Downtown San Luis Obispo Farmers' Market

Higuera St. from Osos St. to Nipomo St., San Luis Obispo, CA
6-9 THURSDAYS

Anchored by nine barbecue grills serving pulled pork, artichokes, and everything in between, the market has more than 80 stalls and food carts in peak season.



A cellist and a rotating lineup of bands play here regularly. There's even a juggler on a unicycle. And if you don't want to circle for parking, take advantage of the bike valet.
