June solstice June 21, 2013 brings northernmost sun

The fact is that Earth's orbit around the sun – and tilt on its axis – have brought us to a place in space where our world's Northern Hemisphere has its time of greatest daylight. The Northern Hemisphere has its longest day and shortest night. Meanwhile, the June solstice brings the shortest day and longest night south of the equator.



The solstice marks when the sun reaches its northernmost point for the year. After the June solstice, the sun will begin its subtle shift southward on the sky's dome again. Thus even in summer's beginning, we find the seeds of summer's end.


Why isn't the hottest weather on the year's longest day?

The solstice marks the height of the sun, but the hottest weather comes a month or two later. That's because the land and oceans have to warm up, too, before the truly hot summer heat can begin. This phenomenon is called the lag of the seasons.

SUPER Super Moon



Get an Super moon


Full moon falls on June 23, 2013 at 11:32 UTC. This full moon is not only the closest and largest full moon of the year. It also presents the moon's closest encounter with Earth for all of 2013. The moon will not be so close again until August, 2014. In other words, it's not just a supermoon. It's the closest supermoon of 2013.

What does supermoon mean exactly? And how special is the June 23, 2013 supermoon? When the moon is closest to the Earth, its gravitational pull is at its peak, which will effect tides. Higher than normal and lower than normal.

Supermoons are important because they focus attention on the moon, and nature in general. But the bottom line is that any physical effects of supermoons are not exactly super. There is no reasonable evidence that they cause super disasters. The effects that people may attribute to them are psychological rather than physical.

Spring brings surprising yet predictable weather
